### The EBacc - English Baccalaureate

### What is it?

The English Baccalaureate (EBacc) is a performance measure for schools, not a qualification for students. It is not compulsory. It shows where students have secured a grade 5 or above across a range of academic subjects (English, maths, science, geography or history, and a language).

Aim = 75% by 2022, and 90% by 2025

# Can students at Kingswood do the EBacc?

Yes, and we encourage and promote the EBacc for students who we believe will enjoy and be successful with this route, but we do not make it compulsory. The EBacc is a more academic pathway and demonstrates a broad academic education. All students will be doing English, maths and science already, so if you want to do the EBacc then choose geography or history and a language.

Mrs Paul (Curriculum Leader for Humanities and Vocational) will be speaking further with some identified students tomorrow morning. We've also shared with the students a new trip to France that we are running for EBacc students

**Top Tip** – Try to make sure that your child has a good 'balance' of subjects in the choices that you make.

**Top Tip** – Look at past reports to check on progress.

**Top Tip** – Ensure the focus is on the subjects they enjoy rather than the teacher or being with a particular friend

**Top Tip** – Be very careful to choose courses that your child will stick with for two / three years – it causes **students** an enormous amount of work to switch subjects.

## The Options Form



- To complete the form you need to identify 6 preferences and list in order. The priority really matters!
- First choice must be Geography / History / French / Spanish
- Some combinations are not allowed e.g. Dance and Drama, or Art and Textiles
- Not everyone gets what they want! It is not guaranteed that all options will run.
- Courses can and occasionally do change



#### Year 8 Options Application Form

Name

Your first choice MUST be either Geography, History, French or Spanish. Put a 1 next to your choice.

You then have five more preferences to indicate.

Number these 2/3/4/5/6, in order of importance to you.

All preferences will be evaluated for suitability. If we do need to make changes, then we will communicate with students and/or parents.

#### Subject combination restrictions:

There are some subject combinations that we do not allow students to do (because the government believes them to have too much subject overlap). si Combinations that are not allowed include:

- Art / Textiles (you can only do one of these two)
- Dance / Drama (you can only do one of these two)
